

Announcement regarding the initiation of the elaboration of the draft law for amending Law no. 132/2012 regarding the safe conduct of nuclear and radiological activities

In the execution of the provisions of Article 9 of Law no. 239/2008 regarding transparency in the decision -making process and the provisions of Law no. 100/2017 regarding the normative acts, the National Agency for the Regulation of Nuclear and Radiological Activities (hereinafter - ANRANR) announces, starting with May 07, 2025, about the initiation of the procedure regarding the elaboration of the draft law for the modification of Law no. 132/2012 regarding the safe conduct of nuclear and radiological activities.

The purpose of elaborating this draft law consists in specifying some terminologies and regulations stipulated by this law, their consolidation and updating in the aspect of correlation with the requirements, provided by Law no. 100/2017 regarding the normative acts, Law no. 131/2012 regarding state control, Law no. 213/2024 regarding the control of the trade with strategic goods and by some other normative acts.

elaboration and approval of the project of this normative act is based by the provisions of art. 11 letters c) and k) of Law 132/2012 regarding the safe conduct of nuclear and radiological activities, as well as the needs in updating and bringing in accordance with some provisions of the law cited with the provisions of the normative acts, including to the aforementioned. 132/2012 regarding the safe conduct of nuclear and radiological activities, but also to the correlation, coherence and improved applicability of the provisions of this law.
